What is Family Dispute Resolution?

Family Dispute Resolution, also known as Mediation, is a process for people experiencing relationship difficulties which allows them to resolve their disputes during & after separation or divorce.



FDR focuses on helping families reach agreements about parenting that puts the interests of children first.

The process of FDR aims to empower parents to make their own decisions and resolve their own conflict to avoid lengthy court battles.
